We continue to seek and procure sustainable raw materials to support Hartz innovative products.

100% of the tuna fish used in Hartz Products is sourced from MSC certified suppliers (Marine Stewardship Council (MSC) is an international nonprofit on a mission to end overfishing and ensure seafood is fished sustainably.

Our Ohio manufactured dog pads contain 100% PEFC certified sustainable paper pulp.

Electricity powering the Hartz's USA manufacturing facility is offset by 100% renewable energy credits. We aim to increase the energy efficacy of our equipment and processes. We have converted all the lighting in our distribution & manufacturing centers to energy efficient LED fixtures.

Every year over 3000 Metric Tons of CO₂ (mtCO₂) is kept out of the environment.

Our new energy-efficient lighting saves over 40% on electricity per year.

We are transitioning to more environmentally friendly packaging materials.

Converted 25% of the business to include some form of plastic recycled content.

Implementing up to 50% PCR (Post-Consumer Recycled) material in plastic bottles.

Replacing virgin paperboard to material that is sustainability sourced and recyclable.

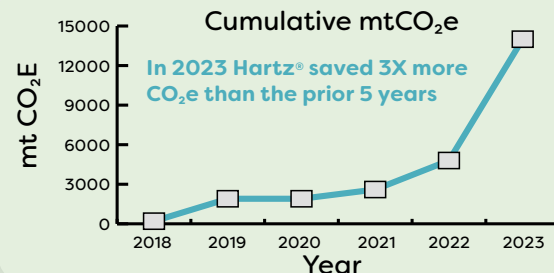
